**THE WORK** Meanwhile, the work continues. Since my last newsletter, I have worked on upgrading the PHP version of the server for several websites hosted by ABA Tech. This provides the highest level of security and performance for the sites we host. I have also been working on a few new websites for our churches. Additionally, I have added a new section to the ABA Tech website for Free Templates. This section offers a host of templates for common church functions such as Easter services, Egg Hunts, Ice Cream Socials, Sunday School Drives, Fall Festivals, Trunk or Treat's, etc. Churches that wish to host and advertise these events can choose a template from the section, add it to their cart, and provide ABA Tech with the necessary details such as church name, location, date and time of the event, etc. and we will customize the template and return it to the church for printing or use on social media. Each template comes formatted for either post card, flier, or social media sizes. ABA Tech also continues to work with the Louisiana Missionary Baptist Seminary & Institute, most recently to redesign the school seal/logo and letterhead to a much more elegant design that we are all very proud of. Soon, we will also be adding online classes to the Imbis.org website.
