

Hello to all the ABATech followers! Thank you for your continued interest in this ministry.

In September, I flew to Indiana to work with missionary Scott Bourland on the install of a new PTZOptics camera and computer system that will handle both the streaming and projection for their in-house displays. I took one day away from my regular job to be able to fit the trip in, flying out on Saturday and home on Monday, but the project was a success and I definitely enjoyed the fellowship with Bro. Scott and such a sweet congregation! The congregation at Grace MBC have been very invested in our lives over the last several years through social media, and it was good to spend some time with them in-person.

The next project in the pipeline is a possible TV install at Central in Bastrop, Louisiana. Central is in the same local association as Hyde Park where I spent four years on staff, so it will be good to get back to my "old stomping ground" if the project is approved at their next business meeting.

Speaking on Hyde Park - I received some very sad news from there back on August 6th, but I am excited to share with you what God has been doing as a result. First let me say that on July 22, Sis. Carla Wollerson from Hyde Park celebrated her birthday. I sent her a text that day to wish her a happy birthday, and she replied, "Oh brother Brandon, thank you! And oh how I wish I could hear you sing that 'Alabama' song again." She was referring to a gospel song the group Alabama recorded, and I sang at Hyde Park, called "Oh the Lord Has Been Good to Me." I quickly grabbed my guitar and recorded the song on the Voice Memo app on my cell phone, and texted it back to her. A few minutes later, she replied, "Oh thank you Bro. Brandon! I'm so excited that now I can listen to it any time I want!" Two weeks later, Sis. Carla lost her life in a tragic car accident at mile marker 114 on I-20 in West Monroe. When I got the news, I could not stop thinking about our last conversation, and her excitement about that song. I called her husband, Bro. Pete, and let him know that the Lord had burdened my heart to do something special, and that in lieu of sending flowers, I wanted to record a gospel album to include that song, and dedicate it to Sis. Carla. I was surprised when he told me that he had been listening to the song! The Lord has opened all the doors to make this recording possible, and soon I will be going into the studio in Nashville to work on this project with some of the best musicians in the business. The album will even feature some new songs written by a GRAMMY nominated singer/songwriter who has graciously offered to write for the album.

Everywhere I go since August 6th, I have been singing Oh the Lord Has Been Good to Me and sharing the story of Sis. Carla, and Bro. Pete's testimony that despite his tragic loss, the Lord has been (and still is) good to him, and to us all. I have sung a lot of songs in a lot of churches throughout the years, but I have never seen a song minister to congregations the way that this one has been. Literally, everywhere I sing it, I can visibly see people worshiping in their pews, and several have shared their own testimonies with me afterwards. Please pray for this recording and how the Lord can use it in conjunction with my ministry as I travel to do ABATech projects, preach revivals, etc.
